FELL PONY CLASSES

Class 1: Stallions (3year olds and over must be fully licensed)

Class 2: Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 3: Two Year Old Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 4: Three Year Old Filly or Gelding

Class 5: Mares without foal at foot, 4 years and over

Class 6: Mare with foal at foot

Class 7: Foal (To be at least 3 weeks old on show day and eligible for registration in the Fell Pony Stud Book)

Class 8: Geldings, 4 years and over

Class 9: Veteran (15 years and over)

Special A) FPS Midlands West Support Group Championship. Highest placed eligible pony, owned by a fully paid up member, resident in the Area, from each Fell Pony In-Hand Class. Champion and Reserve will represent Midlands West for the Bewcastle Boy Blue Inter Area Final at the Southern Breed Show on Sunday 9th September 2018 at Berkshire College of Agriculture SL6 6QR. please ensure that you wear a red armband showing your willingness to attend). MWSG membership can be taken on the day of the show

Special B) Youngstock Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from classes 2, 3, 4 & 7)

FPS Breed Rosette: Awarded to Youngstock Champion (Owner of ponies to be a current FPS member)

Special C) Adult Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from classes 1, 5, 6, 8 & 9)

FPS Breed Rosette: Awarded to Adult Champion (Owner of ponies to be a current FPS member)

FELL PONY RIDDEN CLASSES

Class 10: Novice Pony in its first season under saddle (Snaffle bridles only)

Class 11: Novice Pony not to have won a 1st prize of £10 before Jan 1st 2018 (Snaffle bridles only)

Class 12. Intermediate (Not have qualified for RI, HOYS or Olympia).

Class 13: Traditional Ridden Class (Walk and Trot only)

Class 14: Open Ridden Class

Class 15. Veteran Ridden (15 years or over)

Class 19: Class 20: Foal (To be at least 3 weeks old on show day and eligible for registration in the Dales Pony Stud Book)

Class 20: Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 21: Two year old Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 22: Three year old Filly or Gelding

Special D) Youngstock Championship (1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 19, 20, 21 and 22)

Special E) Adult Championship (1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 16, 17, and 18)

- 4 Part Bred Horses/Ponies registered with their Native Breed Part Bred Stud Book**
- 5 Highest placed Mini rider aged under 12 years on 1st January 2018**
- 6 Highest placed junior Rider under 18 years on 1st January 2018**

- The two highest placed ponies in each section at each qualifying show will qualify for the 2019 NPS Supreme Final to be held at Addington Manor Equestrian Centre, Addington, Buckinghamshire in April 2019 and also be eligible to be chosen to represent their Breed, NPS Area or other team in the Team Challenge which will be incorporated into the 2019 Championship Final.
- Qualifying rounds are open to competitors from the UK and elsewhere. All qualifiers will receive a qualification card.
- The Final will run in accordance with the 2018/2019 NPS Dressage Rules which will be available to all NPS Members. Copyright All Rights Reserved 2019
- Horse/ponies must be ridden at the Final by the qualifying rider.
- Those qualifying for the Final must be fully paid up Dressage, Qualifying or Life members of the NPS for 2019 in order to compete at the 2019 Supreme Dressage Final.
- Please state on entry form which of the above sections you are eligible for.
- Please note: Snaffle bits only (No Wilkie Snaffles), and no spurs allowed.

SHOW RULES

1. Exhibitors of Fell and Dales ponies must be current members of either the Fell Pony Society and/or the Dales Pony Society. The showing rules of each Society apply to the appropriate classes.
2. Classes are only open to ponies registered in the Fell Pony stud book and the Dales Pony stud book.
3. The current showing rules of each Breed Society apply to the appropriate classes. Please contact the Breed Society concerned for a copy.
4. The organisers reserve the right to combine or divide any class as necessary. Efforts will be made to prevent classes clashing, but in the event of a clash, classes will not be held up and the exhibitor must decide which to enter.

COMPLAINTS: We do not encourage complaints. This is intended as a fun show, to be enjoyed by all. If you really must complain, your complaint must be accompanied by a fee of £20.00, which will only be returned if the complaint is upheld.
